This is a content removal request regarding publication on the website https://ednakarnaval.com/, which is stored within your servers.

I am addressing you on behalf of the Cybercrime Department in the Israeli State Attorney's Office. Within the duties of the department, we deal with illegal content published online, on websites, on social media, etc.

It has got to our attention that the website mentioned above published an article containing content that violates the Israeli law. The article reveals the name of a suspect, which accused by his daughter of committing indecent acts and rape her in her childhood. A judicial gag order (attached) has been issued, restricting publication of the sociology expert names, addresses or any other information that may lead to the identification of the victim. The publication below reveals the suspect and the victim's name, thus, violates the judicial gag order.

Moreover, we believe this article violates StackPath's terms of use as we understand it, regarding the use of your servers in order to publish harmful or illegal content:

Article 1. Policy -

"Do not use StackPath in any jurisdiction for unlawful, obscene, offensive or fraudulent content or activity, such as advocating or causing harm...or violating third party rights."

On top of that:

"Do not use StackPath Services to...distribute harmful or destructive programs or content...engage in any other abusive or illegal activities

Hereby we would like to mention an article which indicate the violations mentioned above:

With all of this being said, we believe the activity in the website mentioned above violates your terms of service (in our opinion) as well as the Israeli law. Therefore, it will be much appreciated if you will review the article mentioned above and take action in the matter.
